The woman in the first reading was able to give from her material wealth to support the prophet Elisha. However, while we may not have the same material wealth as this woman, we all possess the wealth of our time. As stewards we should reflect on how we can use our time to serve Christ and the church.

1st Reading: 2 Kings 4:8-12a, 14-16.
Psalm: Psalm 89: 1-2, 15-16, 17-18.
2nd Reading: Romans 6: 3-4, 8-11.
Gospel: Matthew 10: 37-42.

In the Gospel today, Jesus says something very confusing. He says that if you lose your life, you'll find it, and if you find your life, you'll lose it. How can that be? Maybe it would be easier to think of it this way. Suppose for your birthday someone gave you a two-pound box of chocolate candy and you sat down in front of the TV and ate every bit of it. At first it might seem great to have as much candy as you want. But by the time you finished the entire box, how do you think you would feel? Pretty sick, no doubt. Now instead, suppose you invited five of your friends over and shared that candy with them. Instead of having a stomach-ache, you would have a nice memory of the time spent with your friends. See, if your life is only about you, it can be very sad, but if you follow Jesus' example and share your life with others, you will find that life is much happier.
