1st Reading: Wisdom 12:13, 16-19.

Have you ever received a beautifully wrapped birthday present and wondered what could be inside? You might look at its size and feel its weight to guess what it might be. But not until you actually open it will you know for sure. In today's Gospel, Jesus tells his followers some beautifully wrapped stories (parables) with hidden meanings. Not until he explains the parables do they understand the importance of the message. In one of the parables, Jesus uses harvesting wheat to help them understand what happens if they believe the devil's lies instead of staying close to God. He says that just like the wheat and the weeds are separated at harvest time, in the end, those who remain faithful to God will be in heaven and those who have chosen against God won't.

*Jesus, help me to know you so that I will not be led astray.
Help me to be like the wheat instead of the weeds.*

RIFLESSIONE SULLE LETTURE DI QUESTA SETTIMANA

Prima Lettura: Sapienza 12:13, 16-19.
Salmo: Salmo 86:5-6, 9-10, 15-16.
Seconda Lettura: Romani 8:26-27.
Vangelo: Matteo 13:24-43.

La parabola di oggi ha cambiato il volto di Dio per noi. La interpretava con parole luminose padre Giovanni Vannucci, uno dei massimi mistici del '900. Diceva: il nostro cuore è un pugno di terra, seminato di buon seme e assediato da erbacce; una zolla di terra dove intrecciano le loro radici, talvolta inestricabili, il bene e il male. "Vuoi che andiamo a togliere la zizzania?" domandano i servi al padrone. La risposta è perentoria: "No, perché rischiate di strapparmi spighe di buon grano!". Un conflitto di sguardi: quello dei servi si posa sul male, quello del padrone sul bene. Il seminatore infaticabile ripete: guarda al buon grano di domani, non alla zizzania. La gramigna è secondaria, viene dopo, vale di meno. Tu pensa al buon seme. Davanti a Dio una spiga di buon grano vale più di tutta la zizzania del campo, il bene è più importante del male, la luce conta più del buio. La morale del Vangelo infatti non è quella della perfezione, l'ideale assoluto e senza macchia, ma quella del cammino, della fecondità, dell'avvio, di grappoli che maturano tenacemente nel sole, di spighe che dolcemente si gonfiano di vita. La parabola ci invita a liberarci dai falsi esami di coscienza negativi, dallo stilare il solito lungo elenco di ombre e di fragilità, che poi è sempre lo stesso. La nostra coscienza chiara, illuminata e sincera deve scoprire prima di tutto ciò che di vitale, bello, buono, promettente, la mano viva di Dio ha seminato in noi: il nostro giardino, l'Eden affidato alla nostra cura.
