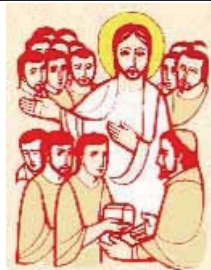

Prima Lettura: Proverbi 31:10-13, 16-18, 20, 26, 28-31. • Salmo: Salmo 128:1-2, 3, 4-5. • Seconda Lettura: 1 Tessalonicesi 5:1-6. • Vangelo: Matteo 25:14-30.

La parabola dei talenti parla della venuta di Gesù per il giudizio universale. Vengono tenute in conto soltanto la fedeltà, l'assiduità e la carità con le quali noi avremo fatto fronte ai nostri doveri, anche se i più umili e i più ordinari.
