THE BAPTISM OF OUR LORD – JANUARY 10, 2021

THEOPHANY



Today we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of Jesus, also known as Theophany. It is a good day to reflect on our own baptisms and their significance for us. The day of Jesus' Baptism was a watershed in His life; it was the day of new beginning. On that day He began His public ministry during which He gave Himself fully in the service of God and all of God's people. On that day Jesus launched forth as the one who came not to be served but to serve and to give His life as the ransom for many. As He set out on that momentous journey for all of us, He was assured of God, His Father's favour, "You are my Son, the Beloved; my favour rests on you", and He was empowered by the Holy Spirit. We too were assured of God's favour and the coming of the Holy Spirit at our Baptism.

WHAT IS MASS?

You've have attended Mass, but maybe you've been wondering "what is Mass exactly?" It is the time set apart for us to gather and celebrate the Eucharist. In Mass we share the very Body and Blood of Jesus that he gives to us in a meal that he himself instituted. The word itself comes from the Latin "missa" which means "dismissal" and comes from the Latin ending of the Mass. The word "Mass" shows us something important. What we do when we come on Sunday, when we are nourished with the Body and Blood of Christ, is meant to give us strength to go out into the world and help nourish it with our good works.

THIS WEEK'S READINGS

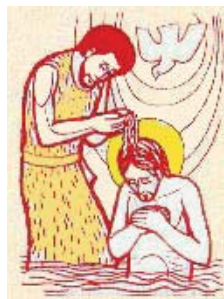

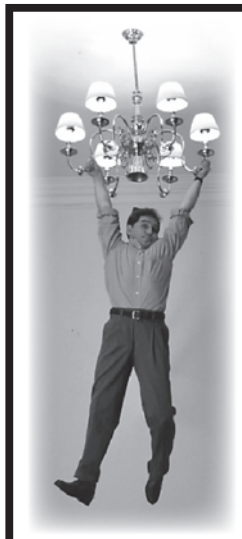
