REFLECTION ON STEWARDSHIP

In today's second reading St. Paul says that "whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God." As stewards, we can glorify God through our work by realizing that our daily tasks can be the sacrifices we offer up to God. Therefore, let us strive to intentionally say a prayer every morning asking God to help us glorify Him throughout our day.

WHAT IS MASS?

The Entrance Procession

We come to Mass from a variety of places. We are groups of people in one common space but we aren't yet a common group of people. The Entrance Procession begins with song, either the Entrance Antiphon or a hymn. The liturgical ministers and the priest(s) enter the assembly. They, like us, are coming from different places, but all end up at the altar. In a real way they are representative of all of us.

While it might seem like this is just a way for people to get from Point A to Point B, it is more than that. It is a sign that we are all on this journey to the altar, and more than that, we are all on a journey to heaven. If we can understand the Mass as our participation in the heavenly banquet, the Entrance Procession is a physical sign of our getting ready to join in.

FASTING & ABSTINENCE

Abstinence: All Catholics, aged 18-59, are obliged to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent.

Fasting: Catholics, aged 18-59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means one may eat 1 meal, and if needed up to 2 additional meals that together do not equal the regular meal (unless health conditions require an alternative).

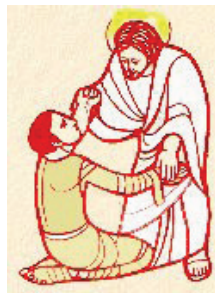

THIS WEEK'S READINGS

1st Reading: Leviticus 13:1-2, 45-46.

...Whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God." —1 Cor. 10:31



How could what I eat or drink glorify God? St. Paul reminds us in this reading to remember God and give him glory for all the normal, everyday things we do in our lives. It's easy to forget and take things for granted, but everything is a gift from God.

Paul also reminds us to be kind to others in everyday situations. We can make choices like holding the door for others, when all we want to do is get into the place we are going. We can choose to be last in line, allowing others to go before us and offering that as a prayer. These are all small ways we can give glory to God—and show God's love—in our daily lives.

Dear Lord, I don't always feel like I can do great things to show you my love. Please help me to find small ways every day in my own life to give you glory.

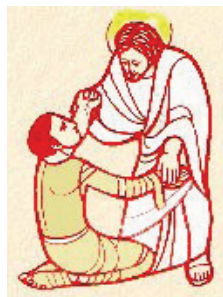
