The Prayer of the Faithful

Part of the Liturgy of the Word, sometimes this is also called the General Intercessions or the Universal Prayer. If there is a deacon, he leads the prayers, if there is no deacon a lay person does. Here we pray for the needs of the Church and the world. Often it is informed by the Scripture readings, but they also should respond the real world needs going on outside the church doors. Here we ask God in a very deliberate way to hear and answer our prayers.

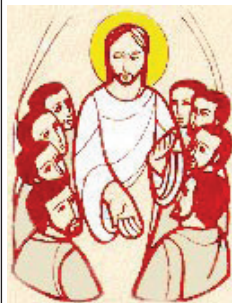
RIFLESSIONE SULLE LETTURE
