WHAT IS MASS?

The Preface

The Eucharistic Prayer begins with us offering our thanks to God. The whole Mass, and in particular, the whole Eucharistic Prayer, is about thanksgiving but in a special way, as the prayer opens, we are reminded to give God thanks. However, we do not just give thanks in some abstract way, rather, we are called to give thanks in ways specific to the time of year, person, or event that the Church is commemorating. That specific moment is called the Preface and it comes right before the Holy, Holy, Holy. The Preface is a moment where we can recall specific things we are thankful for: Christ becoming human, the Apostles, knowing the care of the Lord, the role of Mary in salvation just to name a few. This is a wonderful moment at every Mass to thank God for the various things he has done and is doing for us.

FIRST COMMUNION

Families should be working on First Communion sessions #5 and #6 for the month of May.

CONFIRMATION

Students should be working on session #11 for the month of May.

REFLECTION ON STEWARDSHIP

Before His ascension, Jesus tells His apostles, and us, to go into the world and spread the Gospel. To be authentic stewards we can't hang up our faith on the door as if it were a jacket we took off when we walked into the office. Rather, we should realize that living as a disciple of Christ at all times and showcasing the joy of being a Catholic is perhaps the greatest good we can do in evangelizing our neighbour.

COVID RESTRICTIONS

Current Covid-19 restrictions limit the number of people in the Church to 10 persons, so the Cardinal has canceled all public Masses. The Church will remain open for private prayer, Tuesday & Thursday 8am –11am and Wednesday & Friday from 8am to 12 noon.

They knew Jesus died on the cross, but here he was, alive and well! Jesus' words to them—"Peace be with you"—are the same words he says to us. We have nothing to fear because Jesus is with us.

Lord, help me to remember that even in the worst of situations, you are with me.
