# THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY – MAY 30, 2021

## WHAT IS MASS?

### The Sanctus

Throughout the liturgy we have the opportunity to be united with God, culminating of course in the reception of Holy Communion. However, at the start of the Liturgy of the Eucharist we have the opportunity to sing the glory of God with the angels in heaven. The *Sanctus*, the Holy, Holy, Holy, is a hymn based off of Isaiah 6:3 and Revelation 4:8. Both of those passages invite us to a heavenly vision where angels and heavenly creatures sit around the throne of God and sing His praises. We join with those angels in a very real way at every Mass when we sing the same song to the same God in the same glory. The Sanctus, is a moment in the liturgy where we join with all of heaven and look forward to our participation in the heavenly banquet.

## REFLECTION ON STEWARDSHIP

Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity which we profess every time we make the sign of the cross saying "in the name of the Father, and the Son and the Holy Spirit." St. Francis de Sales recommends that we "make spiritual aspirations to God by short, ardent movements of [our] hearts." Therefore, the next time we experience a difficult moment in our lives or ministries, let us not despair but boldly invoke all three persons of the Trinity and make the sign of the cross.

## COVID RESTRICTIONS

Current Covid-19 restrictions limit the number of people in the Church to 10 persons, so the Cardinal has canceled all public Masses. The Church will remain open for private prayer, Tuesday & Thursday 8am –11am and Wednesday & Friday from 8am to 12 noon.

If you were baptized when you were a little baby, you won't remember what happened, but your family remembers. Ask them and they'll tell you that the priest or deacon poured water over your head three times saying "In the name of the Father... and of the Son... and of the Holy Spirit." When we enter a church, we bless ourselves with holy water, using the same words. In the Gospel today, Jesus commands that this blessing be used to change us from ordinary human beings into his disciples who live like children of God. On this Holy Trinity Sunday, we remember how much God loves us, as Father, as Son, and as Holy Spirit.

Please keep me close to you always, my God.*
