WHAT IS MASS?

Memorial Acclamation

After hearing the words of the Institution Narrative and being shown the Body and Blood of Christ, the people of God respond to the presider's words "The mystery of faith" with one of three acclamations. The Memorial Acclamation is a moment where the whole people of God profess what is at the heart of our faith: that Christ died and rose for us and will return. While we wait for his second coming we profess this faith and share in the Eucharist, in his Body and Blood. It serves as a reminder for us that the Eucharist is not a one-time Sacrament. We are called to profess our faith until Christ comes again and part of that profession is sharing in the Eucharist.

REFLECTION ON STEWARDSHIP

In today's Gospel we hear about the parable of the mustard seed in which Jesus explains that the tiniest seed can grow into the largest tree that houses many birds of the air. The mustard seed represents the Gospel message that began with a few people 2000 years ago and has now spread all over the world. As stewards, we should play our part in helping the tree continue to grow through the gift of our time and talents.

Have you ever been to Disney World or Disneyland? There are all sorts of theme rides and displays, plus spectacular fireworks. Wouldn't you think that God's kingdom would exceed any kingdom here on earth? In our Gospel today, we read that God's kingdom is spectacular, but in a very quiet way.

There are no loud sounds, unusual sights, or fast rides. Jesus compares his kingdom to a tiny seed that secretly begins to grow underground and, when the time is right, emerges and becomes a great tree that gives shade and shelter. God does not want to shock our senses; instead he wants to capture our attention with wonder and awe and challenge us to share this with others until his kingdom gives shelter to all who come looking for his love.

Lord, when I really look at the world around me, I am amazed by your greatness. Help me to share your love in quiet, simple ways that will bring others to worship you with wonder and awe.
