## WHAT IS MASS?

### The Lord's Prayer

Have you ever struggled to pray? The Apostles asked Jesus for help in prayer and to help them Jesus gave what we now call the Lord's Prayer. Said at every Mass and in many other settings, this prayer is often understood as the model of all other prayers. It is a prayer that acknowledges God as Father, a Father who cares for us. It also asks that we be given food for the day's work, forgiven, and kept safe from spiritual harm. We say this prayer in Mass at the start of the Communion Rite. Before the reception of Holy Communion we pray this prayer, from Jesus himself, which is a summary of all that we could ever ask for. It is a wonderful reminder of the work we are nourished for at Communion: to acknowledge God as our Father, to do His will, to worry about today only, to forgive, and to be protected from spiritual harm.

## REFLECTION ON STEWARDSHIP

While summer is a beautiful time for rest and vacation, it should never be a vacation away from God. If we're not using the summer as an opportunity to grow deeper in our relationship with Christ, we are not making the most of our time. Along with our time of leisure, we should try to use our time to volunteer with various summer programs including Catholic summer camps across the diocese.

## THIS WEEK'S READINGS

In today's Gospel, we hear two accounts of Jesus healing. In one account, a woman was healed simply by touching Jesus' clothing. In the other account, Jesus restored the health of a child who had already died. These stories can make us wonder why Jesus doesn't heal everyone so there will be no more suffering or pain. The question remains, do we have faith, even if he doesn't answer our prayers the way we wish? Do we trust that he still loves us and accompanies us even during our darkest moments? Do we believe that by his death and resurrection, we can look forward to a time when there will be no more suffering? We may not understand God's plans for us, but we can be assured that ultimately they are for our good because "God is love" (1 John 4:8) and love conquers all evil.

*Lord, save me from my doubts. Help me remember your goodness at all times.*

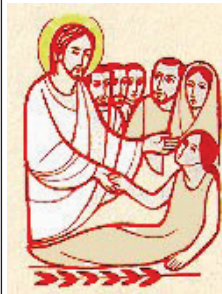
### **RIFLESSIONE SULLE LETTURE**
