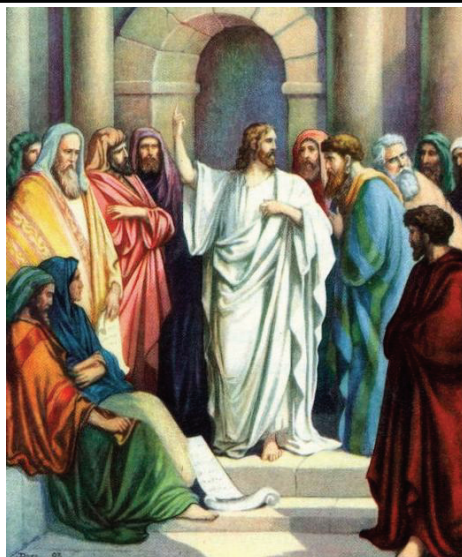

WHAT IS MASS?

Lamb of God

After the Lord's Prayer comes what is sometimes known as the Fraction Rite. Here the people of God sing Agnus Dei, 'Lamb of God'. In this acclamation, we join with John the Baptist in proclaiming Jesus the 'Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world'. While we are singing, the priest takes the Host, breaks it, and places a small piece in the chalice. The action of the breaking the Host, the fraction, recalls for us the action of Jesus at the Last Supper, breaking bread with his apostles. The adding the Host to the chalice is a visible reminder of the full presence of Christ in the Eucharist. It is also a hold-over from the Early Church when the Eucharist would be taken to the sick during Mass. By acclaiming Jesus as the Lamb of God we are reminded of all of these things: how he forgives our sins, how he gives us the Eucharist, and how we are all called to be in communion with one another.

THIS WEEK'S READINGS

1st Reading: Ezekiel 2:3-5
Psalm: Psalm 123:1-2a, 2b, 3-4
2nd Reading: 2 Corinthians 12:7-10
Gospel: Mark 6:1-6

When the sabbath came he began to teach....and many...said "Where did this man get all this?..."
—Mark 6:2

Have you ever heard these sayings: "You can't judge a book by its cover" or "Still water runs deep" or "All that is gold does not glitter"? Each of these statements cautions us to look deeper before deciding the value of something or someone. In today's Gospel, we see that people in the synagogue had trouble believing that Jesus could interpret the scriptures because they knew him as just another one of their neighbors. They knew his family and considered them ordinary people. How wrong they were about Jesus! We sometimes make the same mistake when we see someone who does not appear to be knowledgeable or successful and judge him or her without really knowing them. The Gospel passage concludes with an observation that Jesus was unable to perform many miracles there because of their lack of faith. How many blessings have we missed that could have come through people we dismissed?

Lord, help me treat all people with love, respect, and dignity because everyone has a valuable role in your plan.

RIFLESSIONE SULLE LETTURE

Prima Lettura: Ezechièle 2:3-5

Salmo: Sal 123:1-2a, 2b, 3-4

Seconda Lettura: 2 Corinzi 12:7-10

Vangelo: Marco 6:1-6



Nella storia, nel quotidiano più ordinario, il Dio eterno si fa prossimo dell'uomo. Attira la sua attenzione e gli invia dei "segni": per esempio, facciamo l'esperienza inattesa del suo aiuto; incontriamo un uomo che testimonia di lui con forza. La sua preghiera ci coinvolge e noi "prendiamo gusto a essere con Dio".

Ascoltiamo la sua parola in modo nuovo. Scopriamo subito il suo intervento negli avvenimenti della nostra vita e scopriamo sempre più chiaramente il "filo conduttore". Ma può accadere che talvolta percepiamo l'incontro con lui come una esigenza che ci disturba, che ci irrita e ci provoca. È necessario abbandonare la terra ferma, osar affrontare l'ignoto, forse cambiare.

Gesù viene nella sua città natale. L'interesse che suscita aumenta sempre di più. Il suo insegnamento suscita meraviglia. Da lui emana una saggezza indicibile. Ma molto presto l'attrattiva che egli esercita si altera: La gente è stupita: "Dove gli vengono queste cose? Non è costui il carpentiere?", rampollo di una famiglia ordinaria? E trasmetterebbe una nuova dottrina? Annuncerebbe una esigenza?

È per questa ragione che i contemporanei di Gesù rifiutano di riconoscere l'azione di Dio nell'avvenimento. E non è tutto: deformano l'evento di Cristo e lo trasformano in "scandalo", in una forza del male che spinge al peccato. Tale interpretazione "tenebrosa" finisce per rassicurarli, dopo una simile provocazione.

Ecco una tranquillità pagata molto cara! La fede in Dio e la redenzione in Gesù Cristo diventano inaccessibili. Invece, gli abitanti di Nazaret avrebbero dovuto rischiare di abbandonarsi. Soltanto colui che ha una relazione di intimità con il Redentore sarà salvato. Colui che si è blindato nell'autoconservazione rimane chiuso alla salvezza. E sospettare con cattiveria che l'attrazione di Cristo sia una tentazione contro Dio in realtà non fa che rassicurare il suo egoismo, per quanto "ragionevoli" possano apparire i suoi argomenti.
