WHAT IS MASS?

Lord, I am not worthy...

After we acclaim Jesus the Lamb of God and look on the Body and Blood of Christ held up by the presider, the whole people of God say that we are unworthy that the Lord should come under our roof. This is in reference to the story of Jesus healing the centurion's slave, which you can find in Matthew 8 starting at verse 5. While it is true that we are not worthy of the salvation won for us, it is important to remember that the prayer (and the story in Matthew) does not stop there. It ends with a reminder that all Christ needs to do is "say the word and my soul shall be healed". This part of the Communion Rite is a reminder that we need Christ and that Christ loves us so much that he gives himself for us in the Eucharist. We cannot force him to do that, we have done nothing to merit it, but, in total love for us, he offers himself completely for us and we are healed and brought into communion with him.

THIS WEEK'S READINGS

1st Reading: Amos 7:12-15
Psalm: Psalm 85:8ab+9, 10-11, 12-13
2nd Reading: Ephesians 1:3-14
Gospel: Mark 6:7-13

He summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two.... —Mark 6:7

Why do you suppose Jesus sent his disciples out "two by two"? Have you ever had a school or work project where you were part of a team? If everyone does their part, it's much easier to accomplish the task. The task Jesus was entrusting to his disciples was huge! In some places, the disciples were well received, given a place to stay, food to eat, and even clothes to wear. But some villages rejected them. Jesus cautioned them not to feel defeated when this happened, just to "shake the dust from their feet" and move on to the next town. But if you have ever felt rejection, you know that if just one other person stands with you, it can make all the difference in the world. Jesus' strategy to send them out "two by two" provided the support they would need to meet with opposition. When we are standing up for Jesus, people may sometimes reject us, but we do not stand alone. We have other believers, as well as the angels and saints, who God gives us to lean on.

Help me remember, Lord, that you will always give me what I need to accomplish your will.

Da questa testimonianza dipende non solo l'avvenire dell'umanità, ma anche quello della comunità ecclesiale ed il destino di ogni cristiano.
