### WHAT IS MASS?

#### The Post-Communion Prayer

Sometimes we can all use a recap of an event. After we participate in something it is often good to hear about it again because our perspective has changed. Receiving Holy Communion is often like that. We spend the Eucharistic Prayer praying about the effects of the Eucharist and then we receive our Lord in bread and wine. After all the faithful have received Holy Communion the presider prays the Prayer After Communion, sometimes called the Post Communion Prayer. This prayer is a chance for us to hear again about the effects of receiving Holy Communion but also to be reminded of how the Eucharist calls us out into the world. It is a reminder that the effects of the Eucharist do not end at the doors to the Church and, if we truly believe in who we have just received, we are to be transformed for his service. This prayer is then a summary and an invitation. A summary of what we have received and an invitation to be transformed by it.

When you arrive, you find that it is crowded. It's not long before the long lines to get into the pool changing room and to use the rest rooms become a problem. You are very glad that you brought lunch because the concession stands ran out of food. Before long, people are getting irritable as they get more hungry, hot, and tired. Would you give away the food you brought, knowing that it could hardly make a difference with so many people in need?

This must have been a little like the scenario in our Gospel today. Still, a little boy gave up his meager lunch and Jesus performed a miracle that fed thousands with lots left over. The next time you assume that the little you could give wouldn't make a dent in the problem, remember that God can perform miracles!

*Keep me open to sharing whatever I have, Lord. I know that you will do the resting, and refreshing me.*

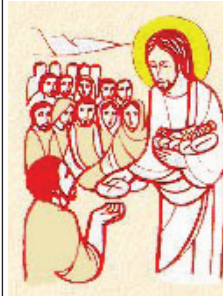

## RIFLESSIONE SULLE LETTURE

Prima Lettura: 2 Re 4:42-44  
Salmo: Sal 145:10-11, 15-16, 17-18  
Seconda Lettura: Efesini 4:1-6  
Vangelo: Giovanni 6:1-15



Tutti gli evangelisti ci riportano il racconto del miracolo della moltiplicazione dei pani. Si tratta di nutrire una grande folla di persone e di seguaci di Gesù, radunati sulla riva nord-est del lago di Tiberiade. Come dimostra l'atteggiamento dei partecipanti, essi interpretano questo pasto come un segno messianico. La tradizione ebraica voleva che il Messia rinnovasse i miracoli compiuti da Mosè durante la traversata del deserto. Ecco perché, secondo questa attesa messianica, si chiamava "profeta" il futuro Salvatore, cioè "l'ultimo Mosè". Infatti, secondo il Deuteronomio, Dio aveva promesso a Mosè prima della sua morte: "Io susciterò loro un profeta in mezzo ai loro fratelli e gli porrò in bocca le mie parole ed egli dirà loro quanto io gli comanderò". Ecco perché le persone che sono presenti durante la moltiplicazione dei pani cercano di proclamare re Gesù. Ma Gesù si rifiuta, perché la sua missione non è politica, ma religiosa.

Se la Chiesa riporta questo episodio nella celebrazione liturgica è perché essa ha la convinzione che Gesù Cristo risuscitato nutre con il suo miracolo, durante l'Eucaristia, il nuovo popolo di Dio. E che gli dà le forze per continuare la sua strada lungo la storia. Egli precede il suo popolo per mostrargli la via grazie alla sua parola. Coloro che attraversano la storia in compagnia della Chiesa raggiungeranno la meta di tutte le vie, l'eredità eterna di Dio.
