The Liturgical Year

The Church has its own calendar which starts on the First Sunday of Advent (late November or early December). Every Sunday the Church celebrates the Lord's Day, the day where we commemorate the Resurrection of the Lord. Throughout the course of the year the Church unfolds the whole of the mystery of Christ and Salvation. It also, over the year, remembers the various Saints and events in the life of the Church. Some of these days have different liturgical colours and different prayers in the liturgy, but they all serve to help us enter more deeply into the mystery of Christ and His Church.

The recently announced Covid-19 restrictions limit the number of people in the Church to 100 persons. After the 8:00am daily Mass, the Church will remain open for private prayer, Tuesday & Thursday until 11:00am and Wednesday & Friday until 12:00 noon.

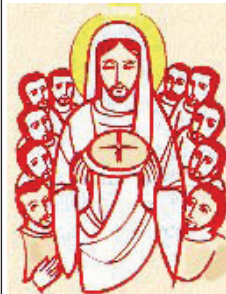
RIFLESSIONE SULLE LETTURE
