





## **HUMANITIARIAN RELIEF FOR HAITI**

The Archdiocese of Toronto has opened a humanitarian relief fund to assist Haiti, which in recent days has been devastated by a 7.2 magnitude earthquake. Then, in the wake of the earthquake, while people are still without housing or are sleeping outside because of a fear of aftershocks, Haiti was struck by Tropical Storm Grace which dumped more than 30 cm of rainfall onto Haiti's coastal areas, resulting in floods and mudslides.

The Archdiocese of Toronto will send donations through <u>Caritas Internationalis</u>, an international confederation of Catholic humanitarian organizations with a long history of disaster relief. Caritas is already on the ground assisting Haitians, as it has been when other disasters have struck that country.

Donations to Caritas will be used for food, water, shelter, clothing and medical supplies.

## WHAT IS MASS?

Liturgical Colors

Most of us have heard that phrase before when talking about how we should be in Mass. The phrase itself comes from the Second Vatican Council's Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, Sacrosanctum Concilium (no. 14) that says "the faithful should be led to that fully conscious, and active participation in liturgical celebrations". This does not mean that we all need to be serving in ministries during Mass. What it does mean is that we have a right and a duty to pray the Mass, to respond, to sing, and to receive Communion (if we are able). By virtue of our baptism we are part of the Body of Christ and as such we are called on to participate in the liturgical life of the Church, as lay liturgical ministers yes, but also by actively praying and engaging the Mass from our pews.

## "We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God." —John 6:69

When Jesus told his followers that unless they eat his flesh and drink his blood they will not have eternal life, many of them left. They could not accept this. If we are honest, we can understand why they had a difficult time with this concept. But there were some followers who did not leave. Peter was one of them. Did he understand?

Probably not. Still he said he was CONVINCED that Jesus is God and that was enough for him to accept every word that came from the mouth of Christ. St. Teresa of Calcutta—Mother Teresa—said "God does not expect us to be successful, only faithful." Even if we don't understand, we can still be faithful to the teachings of Christ. During the Mass when the priest repeats Jesus' words "This is my Body; this is my Blood", we don't need to analyze it, question how it could be, or wonder why Christ would choose to come to us in this way. We can just be thankful that he does!

Oh Jesus, we are convinced that you are the Holy One of God. Strengthen our belief if we begin to doubt.
