HUMANITIARIAN RELIEF FOR HAITI

The Archdiocese of Toronto has opened a humanitarian relief fund to assist Haiti, which in recent days has been devastated by a 7.2 magnitude earthquake. Then, in the wake of the earthquake, while people are still without housing or are sleeping outside because of a fear of aftershocks, Haiti was struck by Tropical Storm Grace which dumped more than 30 cm of rainfall onto Haiti's coastal areas, resulting in floods and mudslides.

The Archdiocese of Toronto will send donations through <u>Caritas Internationalis</u>, an international confederation of Catholic humanitarian organizations with a long history of disaster relief. Caritas is already on the ground assisting Haitians, as it has been when other disasters have struck that country.

Donations to Caritas will be used for food, water, shelter, clothing and medical supplies.

WHAT IS MASS?

Full, Conscience, Active Participation

Most of us have heard that phrase before when talking about how we should be in Mass. The phrase itself comes from the Second Vatican Council's Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, Sacrosanctum Concilium (no. 14) that says "the faithful should be led to that fully conscious, and active participation in liturgical celebrations". This does not mean that we all need to be serving in ministries during Mass. What it does mean is that we have a right and a duty to pray the Mass, to respond, to sing, and to receive Communion (if we are able). By virtue of our baptism we are part of the Body of Christ and as such we are called on to participate in the liturgical life of the Church, as lay liturgical ministers yes, but also by actively praying and engaging the Mass from our pews.

When people bully and degrade others, it should be a warning sign to us not to follow their example. To be a follower of Jesus, we must love like he does.

Lord Jesus, help me to be good on the inside and out.
