#### **WHAT IS MASS?**

#### Postures-Standing

The liturgy is meant to engage the whole person. Our posture then is a means a prayer and a means to foster unity within the community (we all sit, stand, and kneel at the same time). We stand for the Introductory Rites, the Gospel procession and proclamation, the Creed, the Prayer of the Faithful, the preparation of the gifts, the parts of the Eucharistic Prayer that are not consecration, and the Prayer after Communion. Standing is a way we show reverence and thanksgiving which is why we stand for the Gospel and the Eucharistic Prayer (in parts). It is also a posture of offering, which is why we stand for the presentation of the gifts. Most importantly perhaps it is also a posture of openness to Jesus and to the community.

"Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." — Mark 8:34

An old saying states: "Anything worth doing is worth doing well." Here's an example of what that saying means: Let's say that you volunteer to help a sick or elderly neighbor by raking his leaves, but instead of finishing the job, you leave the piles for him to bag and put out to the curb himself. Maybe you grew tired or wanted to do something that was more fun, so you left the task half done. Your intentions were good at the beginning, but unless you finished, you haven't done your job very well.

Jesus was faced with a very difficult task. He didn't want to suffer and be killed any more than any person does, but he knew people might kill him because he was standing up for the truth and trying to do the right thing. Jesus was committed to finishing the task he began out of love for us. He wouldn't stop doing the right things even though he knew he would get killed for it. As followers of Jesus, we too need to help others, regardless of the price we must pay.

Lord, help us to be generous with our love despite the sacrifices we must make.

#### **REFLECTION OF STEWARDSHIP**

In our second reading from the Letter of James we are challenged to have a living faith, a faith that is backed up by action. However, we should first realize that the most generous and loving thing we can do for someone is pray for them. However, after entrusting everything to God, we can then play our part and concretely try to help through proper use of our time and talents.


