THIS WEEK'S READINGS

- 1st Reading: Wisdom 2:12, 17-20
- Psalm: Psalm 54:1-2, 3, 4+6
- 2nd Reading: James 3:16 - 4:3
- Gospel: Mark 9:30-37

Where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there is disorder...the wisdom from above is first of all pure, then peaceable, gentle...the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace for those who cultivate peace. —James 3:16-18

Do I find myself living in the wisdom God gives, in peace and gentleness and the other gifts of the Holy Spirit that I received at my baptism? Or do I find myself more often wrapped up in my wants: wanting my own way, wanting what others have, etc.? Is there peace in my heart when I seek these things, or do those wants created jealousy and selfishness? God wants me to have peace, but peace won't come out of being selfish. Often we need to practice being thankful for what we have and **giving** instead of **getting** in order to find peace.

Dear Lord, please show me how to put selfish wants and desires aside. Help me to find peace through a heart filled with gratitude. Teach me to put others before myself, living out the gifts of patience, joy, kindness, love, and gentleness.

WHAT IS MASS?

Why we sit at Mass

We might not think of sitting as an important posture, but it is. It is the posture that we take when we listen to the Word of God being proclaimed in the readings and the psalm. We also sit to hear and reflect on the homily. We also might sit during the presentation of the gifts and after receiving Communion. It is important to remember that when we sit we are not just mindlessly sitting in Mass, we are still called to be attentive, prayerful, and mindful of the fact that our posture in Mass helps shape our inward disposition. In other words, if we slouch and sit carelessly, it might be harder to participate most fully in the liturgy. Even sitting then we should be mindful of keeping our hearts and minds turned toward God.

REFLECTION OF STEWARDSHIP

St. James in the second reading says, “Where there is envy and selfish ambition, there will also be disorder and wickedness of every kind.” As stewards, we will often face the temptation to compare our gifts with those of others and seek recognition for our own talents. One way to combat this envy and ambition is to intentionally celebrate the talents of others for the gifts of our brothers and sisters are the gifts of the entire Body of Christ.
