1st Reading: Numbers 11:25-29
Psalm: Psalm 19:7, 9, 11-12, 13
2nd Reading: James 5:1-6
Gospel: Mark 9:38-43, 45, 47-48

“There is no one who performs a mighty deed in my name who can at the same time speak ill of me. For whoever is not against us is for us.” — Mark 9:39-40

Jesus' disciples were upset that some other people who weren't followers of Jesus were doing good things for him. They thought they were special because they were in the “in” crowd by following Jesus but the others weren't. Jesus teaches them that it's not about some people being “in” the group and others being “outside” of the group. Everyone who does good things and lives lovingly is on Jesus' side, even if they don't say they are following Jesus! He teaches us that there are plenty of good people in the world that might not go to the same church or even be the same religion as us and they will be rewarded for their good works too.

Dear Lord, help me to be accepting of everyone, not just those that are the same religion or go to the same church as me.

REFLECTION OF STEWARDSHIP

Jesus instructs us in the Gospel to remove anything that causes us to sin for the most important thing in life is the salvation of our souls. Likewise, we should strive to remove anything that hinders us from being better stewards of our time and talents. 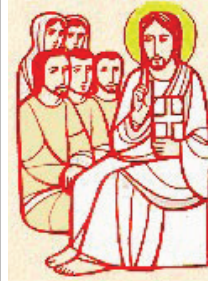
RIFLESSIONE SULLE LETTURE
