"Let the children come to me: do not prevent them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. Amen, I say to you, whoever does not accept the kingdom of God like a child will not enter it." —Mark 10:14-15

Jesus loved spending time with children, even though in his time and culture most people didn't think children were very important or special. He knew that adults have a lot to learn from children, like their playfulness, trust, and ability to love others, and he doesn't want children to ever stop being like that. Jesus challenged the adults to always approach him with the joy and excitement of children because living in God's way should be joyful and freeing, not always so serious and boring. God wants everyone to come to him eagerly, not because it's something we "should" do.

Dear Lord, we want to come to you to love and be loved, without any reservations. Help us to surrender our hearts to you in a simple way.

REFLECTION OF STEWARDSHIP

God gives Adam the gift of Eden and the beauty of creation, yet, He doesn't instruct him to use all these gifts for his mere enjoyment and pleasure but to "till" the land. Gènesi 2:7ab. 15. 18-24 Prima Lettura: Salmo: Sal 128:1-2, 3, 4-5

Seconda Lettura: Ebrei 2:9-11 Marco 10:2-16 Vangelo:



Nel contesto della manifestazione del Figlio dell'uomo e dopo il secondo annuncio della passione, Marco espone - come complemento catechetico - l'insegnamento sulla indissolubilità del matrimonio, e i comportamenti richiesti per fare parte del regno di Dio.

Gesù cambia scena (Mc 10,1): va in

Giudea. Espone con autorità messianica - non a un gruppo ma al popolo - l'indissolubilità del matrimonio come un principio universale. San Marco non entra nelle discussioni dei rabbini sulla legislazione del divorzio. Coglie con fedeltà le parole di Gesù, senza tener conto della clausola eccezionale trasmessa da (Mt 19,9). Marco, rivolgendosi a comunità di gentili, e andando al di là del mondo giudaico, ricorre alla Genesi (Gen 1,27 e 2,24): nell'unione indissolubile del matrimonio brillano, folgoranti, l'immagine e la somiglianza poste da Dio nell'uomo e nella donna. Gesù spiega e chiarisce la volontà del Creatore.


