PLANNING FEASIBILITY STUDY: WE NEED YOUR INPUT!

Planning is an important aspect of any project. In the next few weeks, we will need the help of many as we seek to garner opinions about the best way to proceed in *raising funds to repair the building and allow the church to meet regular operation expenses in addition to paying off outstanding debt*. Our sacred home is essential during these difficult times so we can continue to support the spiritual needs of our parishioners and aid our community.

As our first step, the Archdiocese and St Nicholas de Bari have retained *M & M International*, church fundraising specialists, to interview a broad cross-section of parishioners about the repairs and ministries needed here at St. Nicolas di Bari in mid-November. You may be invited to participate! If you are selected, a letter and Preliminary Case for Support will be emailed and/or mailed to you. Enclosed in the mail will be a link to schedule your interview. Alternatively, a volunteer will call you to schedule an interview.

Participating in a short 45-minute interview will benefit the parish and help us to plan for the work of renewing and completing the renovation of our spiritual home.

If you do not receive an invitation, you will still have an opportunity to help and make your views known in an Open Forum on November 28. Stay tuned for more information.

***"Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away. But of that day or hour, no one knows, neither the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father."* —Mark 13: 31-32**

Jesus told us that one day everything as we know it will end and that we will not know the time when this will happen. That might seem a little bit scary. At the same time, we know that some people die suddenly every day in accidents or from heart attacks or other unforeseen occurrences. Jesus is trying to tell us that we should be living every day as if this is our last. If I were to die today, would I be satisfied with how I lived my life or would I regret doing something or not doing something? What should I take from Jesus' stories and teachings to apply to my life today?

Dear Lord, we do not know when we will meet you face to face, but we hope that when that day comes, you will be pleased with the way we tried to live our lives for you. Please give us the grace to always make choices that will lead us to you.
