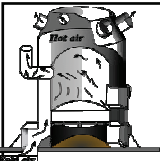
REFLECTION ON STEWARDSHIP

Gospel: Luke 6.17,20-26



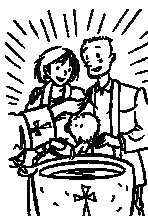
