# SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - FEBRUARY 20, 2022

#### **LOVE ONE ANOTHER**

How far should a Christian disciple's love extend? Are there not times when we might appropriately retaliate in response to a slight or attack? The recollection of who God is. And who we are because we belong to God – the theme of this week's readings— provides a challenging response. Christian love is meant to be limitless, extending beyond the local communities and comfort zones of disciples, and embracing even enemies and evildoers.

# Lent is Approaching

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, which is March 2nd, this year. The season of Len is a time for penance and repentance, for almsgiving and prayer, for working to change attitudes that are not pleasing to God, as we prepare for Easter.

#### **FASTING & ABSTINENCE**

**Abstinence**: All Catholics, aged 18-59, are obliged to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent.

**Fasting:** Catholics, aged 18-59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means one may eat 1 meal, and if needed up to 2 additional meals that together do not equal the regular meal (unless health conditions require an alternative).
