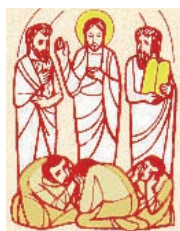

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT– March 13, 2022

LENT



The Season of Lent is often thought of as focusing on the Passion and Death of Jesus Christ. However, the Passion and Death are only the theme of the last few days of Lent. The beginning of Lent focuses much more on the call of Baptism and the covenant that Christ fulfills. This is exemplified in the readings this week. The First Reading is the story of The Covenant. This covenant is that which is fulfilled by the Sacrifice of Christ, but in the Christian sense it is also about the Call of Baptism. The Gospel is the story of the Transfiguration. Here we see a prefiguring of what is to come, both for Jesus at the Resurrection and for us at the end of our lives. We also are given a pretty explicit directive from Christ: "Get up and do not be afraid". This call reminds us to refocus our lives on the important things: Christ Jesus and our living in relationship with him.

The readings for the 2nd Sunday of Lent Year C show us that God is truly present in our world. The first reading tells of Abram's encounter with God and the covenant which was made. The psalm declares "Your presence, O Lord, I seek. Hide not your face from me." The second reading reminds us that God has the power to transform us. And the gospel tells of when Jesus took Peter, James, and John up the mountain and they witnessed his transfiguration.

Fasting: Catholics, aged 18-59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means one may eat 1 meal, and if needed up to 2 additional meals that together do not equal the regular meal (unless health conditions require an alternative).

Le letture della II domenica di Quaresima anno C ci mostrano che Dio è veramente presente nel nostro mondo. La prima lettura racconta dell'incontro di Abramo con Dio e dell'alleanza stipulata. Il salmo dice: «Io cerco, o Signore, la tua presenza. Non nascondermi la tua faccia». La seconda lettura ci ricorda che Dio ha il potere di trasformarci. E il vangelo racconta di quando Gesù condusse Pietro, Giacomo e Giovanni sul monte e furono testimoni della sua trasfigurazione.

RIFLESSIONE SULLA GESTIONE

Il mistero della Trasfigurazione allude all'insegnamento della Chiesa chiamato divinizzazione, in cui crediamo che noi umani saremo fatti come Dio. L'USCCB nella loro Lettera pastorale sulla gestione afferma che "Dio desidera che gli esseri umani siano i suoi collaboratori nell'opera di creazione, redenzione e santificazione; e tale collaborazione implica la gestione nel suo senso più profondo."
