Love God above all



A major theme in the Gospel of Luke is the importance of the care of the poor in the life of discipleship. In the parable found in today's Gospel, Jesus contrasts the life of a rich man and the poor man, Lazarus, who lives in the shadow of the rich man and his wealth. Both die. Lazarus finds himself in heaven; the rich man in the netherworld. The rich

man asks for assistance from Lazarus in his torment. But Abraham reminds the rich man of the good things he had in his life and describes the current situation as a reversal of fortunes. The rich man then asks that Lazarus be sent to warn his family, but this is denied with the reminder that Moses and the prophets have warned of judgment for those who neglect the care of the poor.

In this parable, delivered in the presence of a crowd of listeners, is part of Jesus' response to some Pharisees. These Pharisees are described in Luke's Gospel as "loving money." Jesus observed that the actions of some Pharisees betrayed misplaced priorities: they spoke one way, but acted in another.

Amare Dio sopra ogni cosa

Uno dei temi principali del Vangelo di Luca è l'importanza della cura dei poveri nella vita del discepolato. Nella parabola che si trova nel Vangelo di oggi, Gesù contrappone la vita di un uomo ricco e quella di un povero, Lazzaro, che vive all'ombra del ricco e delle sue

ricchezze. Entrambi muoiono. Lazzaro si ritrova in cielo, il ricco negli inferi. Il ricco chiede aiuto a Lazzaro nel suo tormento. Ma Abramo ricorda al ricco le cose buone che ha avuto nella sua vita e descrive la situazione attuale come un rovesciamento di fortuna. Il ricco chiede allora che Lazzaro sia mandato ad avvertire la sua famiglia, ma questo gli viene negato ricordandogli che Mosè e i profeti hanno avvertito del giudizio per coloro che trascurano la cura dei poveri.

Questa parabola, pronunciata in presenza di una folla di ascoltatori, fa parte della risposta di Gesù ad alcuni farisei. Questi farisei sono descritti nel Vangelo di Luca come "amanti del denaro". Gesù osservò che le azioni di alcuni farisei tradivano priorità sbagliate: parlavano in un modo, ma agivano in un altro.
