WHAT IS THE EUCHARIST?

As Catholics, we believe the Eucharist is the real presence of Jesus Christ. The Eucharist was instituted by Christ in John 6:54 and again at the Last Supper (Luke 22:19, Mark 14:22-25). Contrary to popular belief, it is not a symbol, but the literal body of Christ. This is called transubstantiation.

Receiving the Eucharist (Holy Communion) is a responsibility, not a right. It is meant to be received by Catholics in a state of grace. If you are not presently in a state of grace or are just returning to the Catholic faith, please refrain from receiving until you are able to go to confession.

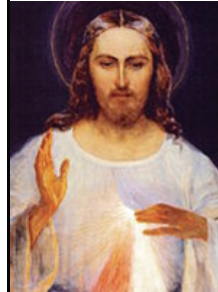

As all of them are being tortured, one of the brothers boldly declares, "you dismiss us from this present life, but the King of the universe will raise us up to an everlasting renewal of life." In the midst of apparent sheer defeat, they remain steadfast in their hope.

Living lives of stewards also means living lives of hope. As we begin to embrace the lens of stewardship and start striving to revitalize our parish communities through the gifts of our time and talents, we could unconsciously expect vast changes to occur over night. This could lead to discouragement as the desired results aren't coming about according to the timeline we had envisioned.
