A short procession (30-45 minutes) will take place in the vicinity surrounding the cathedral followed by Solemn Benediction followed by fellowship.

The Trinity teaches us about the nature of God's love. God's love is relational and communal. Just as the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit exist in perfect love and unity, we are called to reflect that love and

unity in our relationships. In our families, our communities, and our church, we are invited to mirror the self-giving love that characterizes the Trinity. Secondly, the Trinity reminds us of our identity. Through baptism, we are brought into the life of the Trinity. We become children of the Father, united with the Son, and filled with the Holy Spirit. This is not just a theological concept but a lived reality. We are called to live out our trinitarian identity by being people of love, communion, and mission. Lastly, the mystery of the Trinity calls us to humility and wonder. The Trinity is a mystery that we can never fully comprehend with our limited human understanding. This should not discourage us but rather lead us to a deeper sense of awe and reverence. It reminds us that God is beyond our full understanding, and that is a good thing. It means there is always more to discover, more to experience, more to love.


