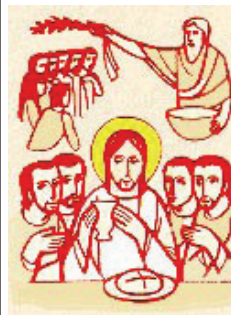

Exodus 24, 3-8
Psalm 115:12-13, 15-18
Heb 9:11-15
Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

The Gospel passage from Mark presents us with the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper. Jesus took bread, gave thanks, broke it, and gave it to His disciples, saying, "Take it; this is my body." Then He took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many." Through these profound actions, Jesus gives us the gift of Himself—His body and blood—under the appearances of bread and wine. The Eucharist is more than just a ritual or symbol; it is the real presence of Christ among us. When we receive the Eucharist, we are not merely remembering a past event; we are participating in the mystery of Christ's passion, death, and resurrection. Jesus offers Himself to us completely in the Eucharist, providing His body as our spiritual food and His blood as our spiritual drink. A feast of the Eucharist allows us to collectively thank God for Christ’s abiding presence made visible in the Eucharist. It is an opportunity to deepen our understanding of the sacrament and adjust our attitude toward it. The Eucharist is a sacrament of life, and if misused, it can have serious consequences. As St. Paul warned the Corinthians, “All who eat and drink in an unworthy manner, without discerning the Lord’s Body, eat and drink judgment against themselves. For this reason, many of you are weak and ill, and some have died” (1 Cor 11:29-30). This feast is a crucial reminder of the importance of approaching the Eucharist with reverence and understanding. It calls us to reflect on the profound mystery of Christ’s sacrifice and to recognize His real presence in the consecrated bread and wine. Let us use this occasion to renew our devotion to the Eucharist and to live out its meaning in our daily lives.

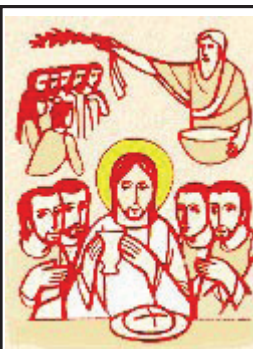

Oggi celebriamo la grande solennità del Santissimo Corpo e Sangue di Cristo, una festa che ci invita a riflettere profondamente sul dono prezioso dell'Eucaristia. Il Vangelo secondo Marco ci presenta l'istituzione dell'Eucaristia durante l'Ultima Cena. Gesù prese il pane, rese grazie, lo spezzò e lo diede ai suoi discepoli dicendo: "Prendete, questo è il mio corpo". Poi prese il calice, rese grazie, lo diede loro e tutti ne bevvero. E disse loro:

"Questo è il mio sangue, il sangue dell'alleanza, versato per molti". In questi semplici ma profondi gesti, Gesù ci dona Sé stesso – il Suo corpo e il Suo sangue – sotto le specie del pane e del vino. L'Eucaristia è molto più di un semplice rito o simbolo; è la presenza reale di Cristo in mezzo a noi. Quando riceviamo l'Eucaristia, non stiamo solo ricordando un evento passato; stiamo partecipando al mistero stesso della passione, morte e risurrezione di Cristo. Nell'Eucaristia, Gesù si dona a noi completamente, offrendo il Suo corpo come cibo spirituale e il Suo sangue come bevanda spirituale. Perché abbiamo bisogno di una festa dell'Eucaristia? Una solennità come questa ci offre l'opportunità di ringraziare Dio collettivamente per la presenza continua di Cristo tra noi, resa visibile nell'Eucaristia. È anche un'occasione per approfondire la nostra comprensione del sacramento del Corpo e Sangue di Cristo e per aggiustare il nostro atteggiamento verso di esso. L'Eucaristia è un sacramento di vita, e se viene usata in modo improprio, può produrre l'effetto opposto. Come scrisse San Paolo ai Corinzi: "Chiunque mangia e beve senza riconoscere il corpo del Signore, mangia e beve la propria condanna. Per questo motivo, molti di voi sono deboli e malati, e parecchi sono morti" (1 Cor 11:29-30).
