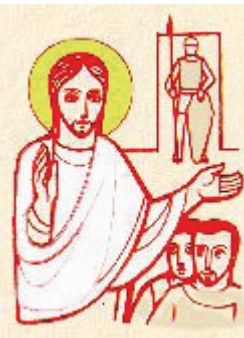

In Genesis 3:9-15, we encounter the story of Adam and Eve's fall from grace in the Garden of Eden. 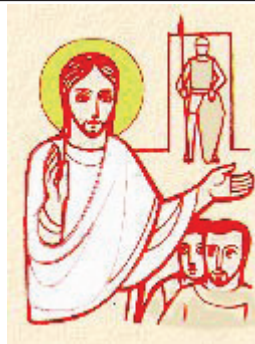
