Archdiocesan Celebration of Saint Michael the Archangel

“The name “Michael” comes from the Hebrew meaning “Who is like God?” Traditionally, the name is associated with his battle-cry and victory over Satan in the face of Satan’s overwhelming pride. The motto of the Archdiocese of Toronto, “*Quis ut Deus,*” is the Latin translation of the Hebrew. Saint Michael’s defeat of Satan, rooted in his humble recognition that nothing is greater than God, offers us an example for our daily lives. With this in mind, I offer the following two points for our meditation stemming from the name of Saint Michael and his famous battle-cry.

Through prayer, we enter more deeply and profoundly into the revealed truths of our faith, discerning right from wrong, holy from unholy, Godly from ungodly, true from false. Saint Michael’s intercession is sure support for each of us as we strive to live as beloved sons and daughters of the Merciful Father. With this ongoing and daily discernment in place, we seek to faithfully and confidently put the fruits of our discernment into action, through service in our homes, families, schools, workplaces, neighbourhoods and communities.

I entrust you all, brothers and sisters in Christ, clergy, consecrated and laity, to the intercession of Saint Michael, praying that he may protect us, be our inspiration, guide, and strength as we proclaim the holiness of God and through our love for one another, seeking the things of God in the good of our brothers and sisters.

San Michele, Archangelo, Patrono dell'Arcidiocesi di Toronto

Festa: 29 settembre

Cosa significa il titolo di "arcangelo"?

Oltre a San Michele, la Chiesa ricorda nello stesso giorno gli arcangeli Gabriele e Raffaele. La Bibbia rivela le specifiche missioni di ognuno: Michele avversario di Satana, Gabriele annunciatore e Raffaele soccorritore. Prima della riforma del 1969 si ricordava in questo giorno solamente san Michele arcangelo in memoria della consacrazione del celebre santuario sul monte Gargano a lui dedicato. Il titolo di arcangelo deriva dall'idea di una corte celeste in cui gli angeli sono presenti secondo gradi e dignità differenti. Gli arcangeli Michele, Gabriele e Raffaele occupano le sfere più elevate delle gerarchie angeliche. Queste hanno il compito di preservare la trascendenza e il mistero di Dio. Nello stesso tempo, rendono presente e percepibile la sua vicinanza salvifica. Quali sono le loro funzioni?

La Sacra Scrittura indica le particolari missioni degli Arcangeli: giorno e notte essi servono Dio e, contemplando il suo volto, lo glorificano incessantemente. In particolare **Michele** ("Chi è come Dio?") è l'arcangelo che insorge contro Satana e i suoi satelliti (Gd 9; Ap 12, 7; cfr Zc 13, 1-2), difensore degli amici di Dio (Dn 10, 13.21), protettore del suo popolo (Dn 12, 1). **Gabriele** ("Forza di Dio") è uno degli spiriti che stanno davanti a Dio (Lc 1, 19), rivela a Daniele i segreti del piano di Dio (Dn 8, 16; 9, 21-22), annuncia a Zaccaria la nascita di Giovanni Battista (Lc 1, 11-20) e a Maria quella di Gesù (Lc 1, 26-38). **Raffaele** ("Dio ha guarito"), anch'egli fra i sette angeli che stanno davanti al trono di Dio (Tb 12, 15; cfr Ap 8, 2), accompagna e custodisce Tobia nelle peripezie del suo viaggio e gli guarisce il padre cieco. La Chiesa pellegrina sulla terra, specialmente nella liturgia eucaristica, è associata alle schiere degli angeli che nella Gerusalemme celeste cantano la gloria di Dio (cfr Ap 5, 11-14; Conc. Vat. II, Costituzione sulla sacra liturgia, «Sacrosanctum Concilium», 8)
