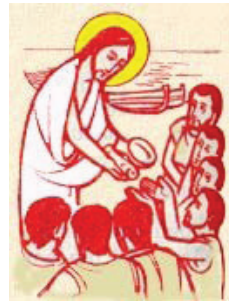

Comment on John 21:1-19



Today's Gospel brings us to the quiet shore of the Sea of Tiberias. After a long, fruitless night of fishing, the disciples are tired and empty-handed — until Jesus appears. With just one word from Him, their nets overflow with abundance. It is a powerful reminder that without Christ, our efforts are empty; but with Him, our lives become full, even beyond what we can imagine. Yet the most beautiful moment is not the miracle of the fish — it is the simple breakfast on the beach. Jesus, risen and glorious, does not stand distant or demanding. He prepares a fire, cooks bread and fish, and invites them to eat. He reminds us that God meets us in our hunger, our fatigue, our ordinary lives — with tenderness and care. Then, turning to Peter, He asks the most important question: **"Do you love me?"** Not "Did you succeed?" or "Did you fail?" — but "Do you love me?" Despite Peter's past denial, Jesus gives him a new beginning, because mercy always has the last word with God. Today, the Risen Jesus asks each of us the same simple question. Let's answer from the heart: **"Yes, Lord, you know that I love you."** And like Peter, let's trust that from that love, Jesus can build something beautiful with our lives.

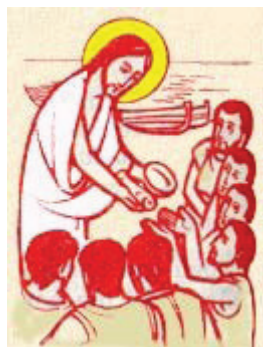

Commento su Giovanni 21,1-19



Oggi il Vangelo ci porta sulle rive del lago di Tiberiade, dove Gesù risorto si manifesta ai suoi discepoli con semplicità disarmante: prepara loro del pesce sul fuoco e del pane, e li invita a mangiare. È l'incontro della tenerezza di Dio con la nostra umanità fragile. I discepoli avevano pescato tutta la notte senza risultato, ma alla parola di Gesù gettano di nuovo le reti, e la pesca è sovrabbondante. È un segno potente: senza di Lui, le nostre fatiche sono vuote; con Lui, anche i gesti più semplici si riempiono di fecondità. Al centro di questa pagina meravigliosa c'è un dialogo che tocca il cuore: "Simone, mi ami tu?" — "Signore, tu sai che ti voglio bene." Tre volte Gesù domanda, tre volte Pietro risponde. È una domanda che oggi risuona anche per ciascuno di noi: **"Mi ami tu?"** Non ci chiede se siamo perfetti, non ci chiede se non abbiamo mai sbagliato. Ci chiede se, nonostante tutto, vogliamo ancora seguirlo con amore. E da quell'amore nasce la missione: "Pasci le mie pecorelle." È l'amore che ci trasforma da peccatori feriti in pastori capaci di cura e di misericordia. Oggi, lasciamoci guardare da Gesù, come Pietro sul lago. Offriamogli tutto: le nostre fatiche, i nostri fallimenti, i nostri piccoli slanci d'amore. E ripartiamo con fiducia: il Risorto cammina con noi e ci affida ancora la meravigliosa avventura della fede. Amen.
