Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ the King

The Gospel of John presents a profound contrast between earthly and heavenly kingdoms. When questioned by Pilate, Jesus declares, "My kingdom does not belong to this world," emphasizing that His authority is supernatural and rooted in truth, not political power. His kingship is demonstrated not in conquest, but in service—washing the feet of His disciples and ultimately dying on the cross for humanity's salvation. This paradoxical kingship, built on sacrifice and love, challenges the world's understanding of strength and victory.

Christ's kingship is both present and future. While His full reign will be revealed at the end of time, when every knee will bow and all will acknowledge Him as King, His kingdom is already active in the world today. We live in God's kingdom now, and recognizing Christ as King means allowing His presence to be felt in our daily lives. This involves cultivating a relationship with Him through prayer and listening, so that we can perceive the countless graces and "angels" God sends to support us in times of trial. As the Church reflects on this solemnity, it calls believers to examine their hearts, to identify areas where they have tried to be the king of their own lives, and to invite Jesus to take His rightful place as Lord and King. In doing so, we participate in the building of His kingdom on earth, where justice, peace, and the dignity of every person are upheld.

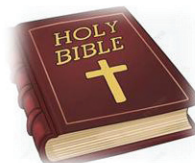

Il Vangelo di Giovanni presenta un profondo contrasto tra il regno terreno e quello celeste. Interrogato da Pilato, Gesù dichiara: "Il mio regno non è di questo mondo", sottolineando che la Sua autorità è soprannaturale e radicata nella verità, non nel potere politico. La Sua regalità non si dimostra nella conquista, ma nel servizio: lavando i piedi ai Suoi discepoli e morendo infine sulla croce per la salvezza dell'umanità. Questa regalità paradossale, fondata sul sacrificio e sull'amore, sfida la comprensione che il mondo ha di forza e vittoria.

La regalità di Cristo è sia presente che futura. Mentre il Suo regno completo sarà rivelato alla fine dei tempi, quando ogni ginocchio si piegherà e tutti Lo riconosceranno come Re, il Suo regno è già attivo nel mondo oggi. Viviamo nel regno di Dio ora e riconoscere Cristo come Re significa permettere che la Sua presenza sia percepita nella nostra vita quotidiana. Ciò implica coltivare una relazione con Lui attraverso la preghiera e l'ascolto, così da poter percepire le innumerevoli grazie e gli "angeli" che Dio invia per sostenerci nei momenti di prova. Mentre la Chiesa riflette su questa solennità, invita i credenti a esaminare i propri cuori, a identificare gli ambiti in cui hanno cercato di essere i re della propria vita e a invitare Gesù a prendere il Suo legittimo posto di Signore e Re. Così facendo, partecipiamo alla costruzione del Suo regno sulla terra, dove la giustizia, la pace e la dignità di ogni persona sono sostenute.
