Sunday Gospel
MATHEW 17:1-9

On the mountain, Jesus is transfigured before them; His face shines like the sun and His garments become white as light. In that radiant moment, the veil is lifted. The disciples’ glimpse who He truly is not only the humble teacher they have been walking beside, but the beloved Son of God, radiant with divine glory. Moses and Elijah appear beside Him, representing the Law and the Prophets. Everything in salvation history points to Christ. Peter, overwhelmed, wants to remain there— “Lord, it is good that we are here.” How often we too wish to stay in moments of consolation, clarity, and spiritual light. Yet the Christian life is not lived only on mountaintops. The voice of the Father interrupts: “This is my beloved Son... listen to Him.” The focus is not on building tents, but on obedience. Discipleship is about listening. Then, as suddenly as the vision comes, it fades. Jesus touches them and says, “Rise, and do not be afraid.” They must descend the mountain and continue toward Jerusalem—toward the Cross.

This Gospel reminds us that glory and suffering are inseparable. The Transfiguration strengthens the disciples before the scandal of Calvary. In our own lives, moments of light are given not to escape reality, but to sustain us through trials. When faith feels dim, we remember the mountain. When fear overwhelms us, we hear His words:

Rise, and do not be afraid.
And above all, we listen.





Vangelo della Domenica

MATTEO 17,1-9

Sul monte, Gesù si trasfigura davanti a loro; il Suo volto risplende come il sole e le Sue vesti diventano candide come la luce. In quel momento radioso, il velo si solleva. I discepoli intravedono chi Egli è veramente: non solo l'umile maestro al fianco del quale hanno camminato, ma l'amato Figlio di Dio, raggiante di gloria divina. Mosè ed Elia appaiono accanto a Lui, a rappresentare la Legge e i Profeti. Tutto nella storia della salvezza rimanda a Cristo.

Pietro, sopraffatto, vorrebbe rimanere lì: "Signore, è bello per noi essere qui". Quante volte anche noi desideriamo rimanere in momenti di consolazione, chiarezza e luce spirituale. Eppure la vita cristiana non si vive solo sulle cime dei monti. La voce del Padre interrompe: "Questi è il mio Figlio amato... ascoltatelo". L'attenzione non è sulla costruzione di tende, ma sull'obbedienza. Essere discepoli significa ascoltare.

Poi, all'improvviso come la visione giunge, svanisce. Gesù li tocca e dice: "Alzatevi e non abbiate paura". Devono scendere dal monte e proseguire verso Gerusalemme, verso la Croce.

Questo Vangelo ci ricorda che gloria e sofferenza sono inseparabili. La Trasfigurazione rafforza i discepoli prima dello scandalo del Calvario. Nella nostra vita, momenti di luce ci vengono donati non per sfuggire alla realtà, ma per sostenerci nelle prove. Quando la fede si affievolisce, ricordiamo il monte. Quando la paura ci sopraffà, ascoltiamo le Sue parole: Alzatevi e non abbiate paura.

E soprattutto, ascoltiamo.
